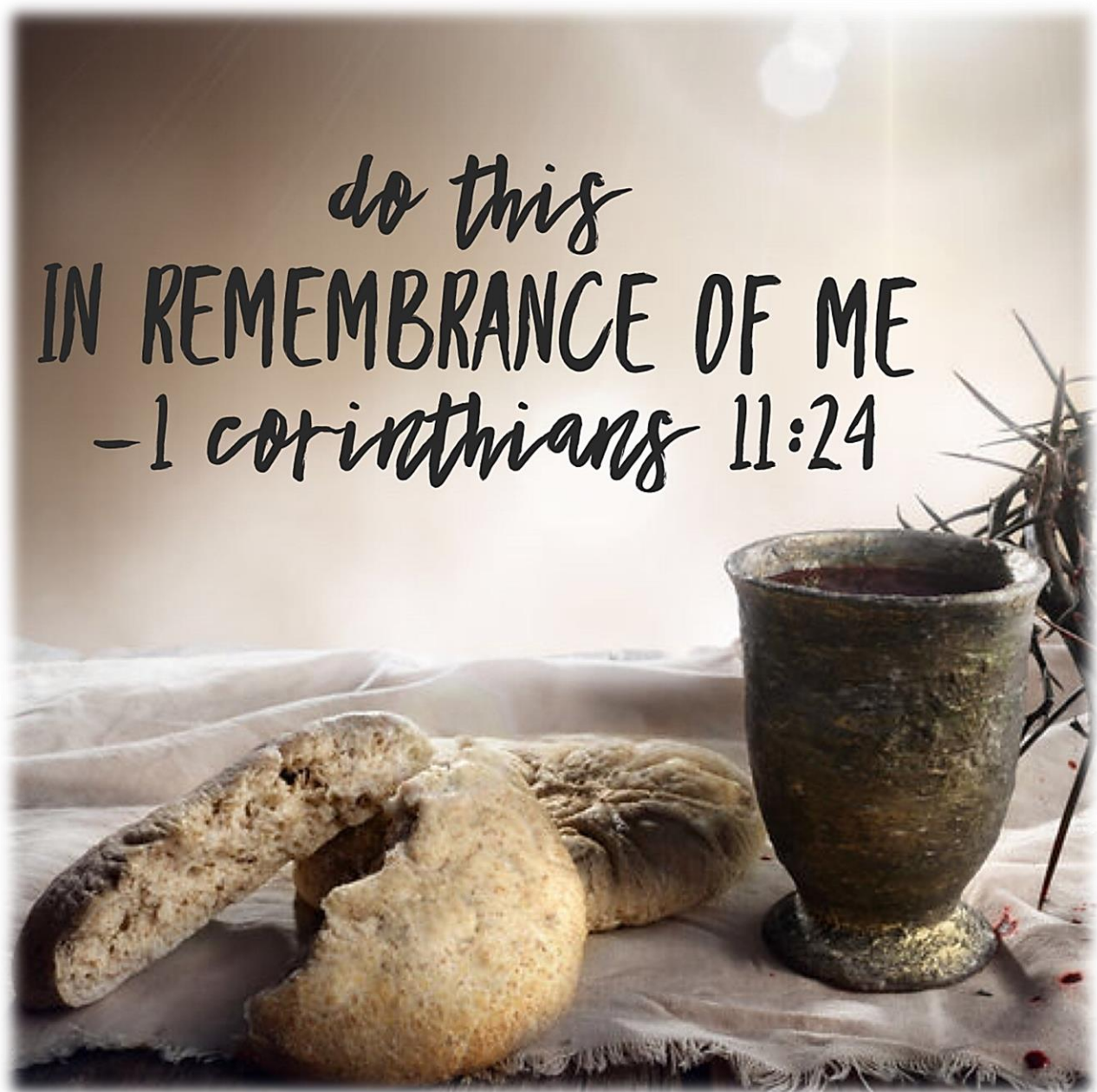

The Crates for Ukraine Mission: *At the request of the Ukrainian Church and our national partners, to provide personal and humanitarian aid from the hands of churches in the U.S. to the hands of churches and displaced communities in Ukraine.* Our church will be filling up 2 crates, while Arden will fill up 4.
