

Statement of Faith – Westminster Larger Catechism Question 101

Q. What is the Preface of the Ten Commandments?

A. The introduction to the Ten Commandments is: I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. In these words God reveals His sovereign being as LORD, in and of himself, eternal, unchangeable, and almighty God, who gives being to all His words and works. God also points here to His covenantal relationship with the Israelites in ancient times and with all His people, so that just as He brought the Israelites out of their slavery in Egypt, He delivers us from spiritual enslavement. Consequently we are bound to accept only Him as our God and to keep all His commandments.

Confession of Sin

O Holy God, we have not worshipped You alone as You clearly command. We have exchanged Your truth for a lie and worshiped created things rather than You the Creator of heaven and earth. The Crates for Ukraine Mission: At the request of the Ukrainian Church and our national partners, to provide personal and humanitarian aid from the hands of churches in the U.S. to the hands of churches and displaced communities in Ukraine. Our church will be filling up 2 crates, while Arden will fill up 4. Once these crates are filled a team from Arden will fly to the Ukraine and help distribute the items collected to those in need.
